## Looking ahead..... Heritage Day

Wednesday 26th September 2018 will be the 140th anniversary of the dedication of four Barrow churches: St. Mark, St. John, St. Luke and St. Matthew. All four were dedicated simultaneously by four Bishops on this date in 1878.

To commemorate this milestone event there is to be a Heritage Open Day event, organised by Barrow Archives Office here at St. Mark's on Saturday 8th September. St. Mark's was chosen as it the one which most closely resembled the churches as they were first built in 1878. The other three original church buildings were later demolished and rebuilt.
