## **Tonight's Sunday Night Live - Cancelled**

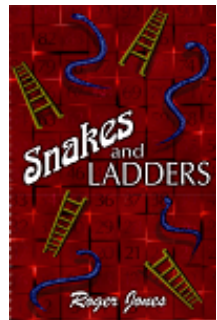
Sadly due to the bad weather conditions Chole was unable to travel up from Gloucester this weekend.... we will try to arrange a new date for later in the year.

## **Reflections - A Story to Tell.**

The sessions are to encourage local people to pass on their stories, led by Steve Fairclough of Mirador Arts at Barrow Library on 12th March and 27th March from 10.00am-12.00pm and 1.00-3.00pm. Steve is keen to hear the stories and memories from today's Barrow residents and find out whether attitudes and events of the past can be life training for today.

*Elizabeth Roberts, who was born and brought up in Barrow, recorded the memories during the 1970s and 1980s and they became a unique record of working class life in Lancaster, Barrow and Preston from 1890 to 1970. They are currently being digitised by the Regional Heritage Centre at Lancaster University.*
